## PURPOSE OF THE POSITION

To conduct age appropriate functional and standardised assessments to clients across the lifespan. In conjunction with the client and/ or their carer identify goals for intervention and therapy for improvements in independence and performance that promotes each clients quality and enjoyment of life, potential and positive experiences within the community.

## KEY ACCOUNTABILITIES

- Work within a multidisciplinary model to provide assessment and intervention for individuals , in conjunction with families and carers when appropriate to address occupational performance issues.
- Conduct functional, standardised and non-standardised assessments relevant to the clients age, goals and diagnosis and or disability
- Work in collaboration with other team members to provide support and a consultative role in your area of expertise to the team and families as required
- Plan, implement and evaluate individual developmental therapy programs and provide timely written assessment reports, including appropriate recommendations
- Engage with external provides in the prescription of assistive technology and home modifications to provide comprehensive recommendations with quotes from recommended suppliers.
- Empower and enable clients, families and carers to access both specialist and mainstream community supports
- Liaise with and provide professional advice to specialist early intervention, mainstream and school transition services involved with the child and family.
- Liaise with and provide professional advice to the Homecare team engaged with the older person
- Participate in multidisciplinary care as appropriate to the client.
- Follow all CatholicCare and program policy, procedures and processes
- Maintain a case load ensuring all plans are current, up-to-date and reviewed in a timely manner
- Provision of information to clients and families about disability and referrals where required
- Attendance at and participation in team meetings, interagency meetings and professional development
- Undertake activities under the direction of the manager for ongoing expansion of the clinical therapies program.
- Other duties as directed from time to time

## KEY COMMUNICATIONS

This role works closely with the Clinical therapies and Home Care team (to receive guidance and exchange information), and clients and their families to build supportive relationships, with in the confines of external funding guidelines.
